Old Features Removed From This Release

The option "1" is no longer available for the "mem-show" command.

Problems Resolved in This Release

ASCII configuration file doesn't show SNMP server's user parameters (Q01407791-01).

IPFIX did not accurately display packet count (Q01515685-01)

QBridgeMib (RFC 2674) did not return any value when queried (Q01391509)

When a MLT link is pulled off from a trunk and then is plugged back in, the traffic through the trunk did not recover (Q01594885).

With auto save disabled, the MAC-security settings were not properly saved in NVRAM and therefore lost after a reboot (Q01592825)

When connecting to a 55xx the cursor on the CLI was hidden due to an ESC sequence sent from the switch (Q01574134-02).

With MAC Security enabled on a stack with large number of ports configured on it, stack instability may occur (Q01641040).

Under certain conditions, the Telnet server did not return the prompt or the banner to client's session (Q01656420-01)

Stack password got corrupted if the stack broke apart (Q01592862-04)

BPDU blocker configured with STG2 does not work after reboot (Q01459111)

A memory leak was detected when MAC Security is enabled / disabled from CLI (Q01511495).

When enable MAC Security on all ports some remain disable (Q01768286). This issue is fixed in 5.0.7 release.
